



Palette setup

1. Label the sides of halfpans with a sharpie.
2. On this template, write the color names in the boxes in the order you wish to place them as a reference to follow.
3. Cut a piece of watercolor paper to 8-1/8" x 2-3/8". Use the paper you paint on most so the colors are as accurate as possible.
4. Tape the paper onto this template. Using a pencil and ruler, create the boxes on the watercolor paper.
5. Begin swatching, making dark-to-light swatches by placing heavily pigmented color on one side, then rinsing the brush and dragging color across the space.
6. After dry, label as desired - brand, color, transparency, etc.
8. Once the swatch sheet is complete and dry, put packing tape over it in single layer to protect it, and adhere inside the lid.
